Like & Dislike

We use the **present simple tense** to talk about things we like and dislike.
Usamos el **presente simple** para hablar de lo que nos gusta y no nos gusta.

1- Positive sentence (Oraciones positivas)

Subject (sujeto)	Verb	Noun/ complement
I (yo)	Like (con plurales el verbo no cambia)	swimming
You (Tú - Ustedes)		football
We (Nosotr@s)		reading
They (Ell@s)		ice-cream
He, (santiago)	likes	cooking
She,(Sofia)		meeting people
It, the cat, the class (el gato)		running

I **like** swimming (me gusta nadar)

She **likes** swimming (a ella le gusta nadar)
